League info EVERYONE should know:

- Online tournament sign-up
 - Easier for you, easier for our counter!
- We will have each MC tourney available on our online store (with prices for our pass holders!). For the 2018 season the rates will be the same online as in the proshop, 2019 we will offer a discount for online signup/payments.
- League Set-up
 - Thursday league play is all day (given you are playing with another member).
 - There are two games played each Thursday as well as a mandatory entry fee of \$5 (for a total of \$15). The entry for the games will be either both or none.
 - Gross skins is played based on your score for each hole. If you receive a birdie on hole one and no one else in your flight does, you win a skin. If you have a birdie on hole two and someone else has a birdie on the same hole, that skin is then “covered up” and becomes a wash. One tie all tie.
 - Net skins uses your handicap in order to even the playing field.
- Tournaments
 - MC tournaments are played in two scoring formats
 - Stroke Play- “You verses the field”. You are playing against all other members in your flight, your cumulative score will be used at the end of your round
 - Match Play- “You verses your opponent”. This playing field is much smaller, typically just you against one other opponent. This is scored on a hole-by-hole basis. If both players score the same on a hole nobody wins and no points are awarded. Each hole is worth one point, with the scoring starting over at each hole.
